



**Nominations for the 2012
Center for School Mental Health
Juanita Cunningham Evans Memorial Award**

Juanita Cunningham Evans was instrumental in the development of the Center for School Mental Health Assistance, which underwent a name change to the Center for School Mental Health Analysis and Action (CSMHA) in 2005 to accompany its new mission as a policy and analysis center, and in 2007 changed its name to the Center for School Mental Health. As an ongoing memorial to Juanita Evans, the CSMH has established an annual award. An annual award will be given to an individual who has significantly impacted the advancement of school mental health policy, research, and/or practice. Nominations for this award should be external (i.e., no self-nominations and no employee of the CSMH) and should include a one page description of the nominee's contributions to enhance policy, research or practice in school mental health. The winner of the award will be recognized and honored at the 17th Annual Conference in Salt Lake City, Utah and will receive one free conference registration for an individual to attend the conference. In addition, the award recipient will be featured on the CSMH website and in the CSMH newsletter. Please include a cover letter with contact information for the individual nominating the candidate.
