CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

The School Health Interdisciplinary Program (SHIP) is a multifaceted approach to continuing education. This regional conference will provide intensive training on all of the eight components of comprehensive school health, including school health services, health education, nutrition, physical education, family and community involvement, staff wellness, school environment (emotional and environmental) and mental health. The School Health Interdisciplinary Program (SHIP) provides a week long intensive training in the summer, targeting school-based and school related staff to provide for continuing education and development. SHIP is co-sponsored by the Center for School Mental Health, University of Maryland School of Medicine, the Center for Mental and Child Health, Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Maryland State Department of Education, and the Department of Juvenile Services.

During the week of August 3, 2009, the Ninth Annual School Health Interdisciplinary Program (SHIP) will take place. SHIP offers sessions with topics of interest to members of the pupil services team, school nurses, physicians, psychologists, social workers, pupil personnel workers, nutritionists, counselors, health educators, health practitioners, school educators, and other team members to implement effective school health services and mental health programs. What makes this institute unique is its focus on *intensive* professional development on topics vital to school health professionals, including mental health, safe schools environment, social skills training, assessment skills updates, nutrition, and adolescent risk behaviors, to name a few.
